To help the Race Committee to determine eligibility, please enclose a current IMS, PHRF or AMERICAP II rating certificate now, if available, with the Entry Form. A current IMS or AMERICAP II certificate will be required before close of Entries on May 23, 2003.

Entry Fee

The standard Entry Fee is \$900 for under 50 feet, \$1,200 for 50 to 70 feet, and \$3,000 for 70 feet and over. A discounted entry fee of \$750 for under 50 feet; \$950 for 50 to 70 is will apply if fully completed entry form and fee is received by March 7, 2003. A \$50 discount will be applied to the entry fee of all Owner/Charterers who are members of US Sailing. Checks should be made out to the "Transpacific Yacht Club".

Entries close on May 23, 2003 and no entry will be refunded after June 20, 2003.

Other required items

Before May 23, 2003, I will supply:

- ◆ Yacht's then current rating certificate.
- ◆ Two 8"x10" glossy (color) photographs of the yacht under sail, suitable for reproduction or posting. They will not be returned. OR: A "2"x2" digital photo at 400 DPI.
- ◆ Any type written corrections or additions to the crew list, complete with names, addresses, telephone numbers, and experience. Any changes made after May 23, 2003 will not be in the Transpac Program.
- ◆ Host/Headquarters Information Form
- ◆ A copy of the yacht's liability policy with Transpacific Yacht Club as an additional named insured.
- ◆ A certificate of *Safety at Sea* seminar attendance of at least 30% of the crew including Owner/Charterer within the last five years.

I hereby agree that the below-named yacht will be outfitted and equipped in accordance with the "Notice of race for the 2003 Honolulu Race", and I further recognize and agree to thoroughly familiarize myself with, and be bound by, and obey all rules and regulations governing this race.

I understand my yacht must pass inspection by June 25, 2003.

WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION FORM

1. I agree to comply with all rules, regulations and race instructions of the Transpacific Yacht Club (TPYC), the rules of US Sailing, the International and Inland Rules, and other rules under which the Race is sailed.
2. I for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns,
 - a. Waive and release any and all claims that I may have against the Transpacific Yacht Club, its Committees, the Honolulu Committee, Transpacific Yacht Race, their officers, directors, members, Committeemen, volunteers, sponsors, employees and agents, or any one or more of them or their executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns (the "Releasees"), including any and all claims for loss or damage caused by the negligence of any of them, arising from my participation, or that of my yacht or any crew member thereof, in the Race and its related activities, including pre-start and post-finish operations, together with any costs, including attorney's fees and other expenses of investigation or litigation, that may be incurred as a result of any such claim whether valid or not, and
 - b. Agree to indemnify and hold harmless the releasees and each of them against any such claim that I or members of my crew or my guests or any one or more of them or their executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns may have or assert and against any costs, including attorney's fees and other expenses of investigation or litigation with respect thereto.
3. I acknowledge that I have sole responsibility for the safety and operation of my yacht.
4. I hereby grant permission to the Transpacific Yacht Club, Honolulu Committee and their respective committees and staffs to transmit any and all communications from or to my yacht during the Race relating to position reports and other information relating to the progress of the yacht and the welfare of the crew during the Race whether the communications are with any government, public or private stations.

5. I acknowledge that after arrival at the finish line off Honolulu, my yacht may, at my request in case of emergency, be led by or taken in tow by a boat operated for the safety of race participants by volunteer committeemen of the Honolulu Committee, or a representative of the Transpacific Yacht Club, and be led or towed to its mooring in the Ala Wai Yacht Harbor, or may at my request in case of emergency, take such a committeemen aboard (who shall become a member of my crew) to assist in entering the Harbor and mooring, all without charge or expense to me; without limiting the generality of the waiver, release, and indemnity above. I hereby agree that should my yacht be damaged in any manner or to any extent by reason of such leading, towing or other assistance, or by reason of any failure or refusal to perform such leading , towing or other assistance, neither the boat, the owner thereof, the releasees, nor any of them, shall have any liability or any claim therefore.
6. I hereby authorize the Transpacific Yacht Club, its officers and agents, as well as the Honolulu Committee, to inspect my yacht to determine that I have complied with the rules and regulations of the Race and acknowledge that by making such inspection TPYC does not warrant the sea-worthiness of my yacht or the safety of the yacht and/ or its crew, that I take full responsibility therefore, and that the purpose of such inspection is to determine that my yacht is equally burdened with the other yachts in the Race so as to avoid any unfair advantage over other yachts in the Race.
7. I hereby grant permission to Transpacific Yacht Club, the Sponsors, and their duly appointed agents, to use for editorial, promotional, and commercial purposes, any and all images produced during the Transpacific Yacht Race of 2003 of my yacht and/ or crew.
8. In the absence of myself or my representative, I hereby authorize the Transpacific Yacht Club, its officers and agents, as well as the Honolulu Committee, to move and/or relocate the yacht while in the Ala Wai Basin, to facilitate the accommodation and mooring of the yachts involved with the Transpacific Yacht Race.

These greetings go on 24 hours a day so no matter what time you cross the finish line, your party will be waiting.

We have provided you with a Host/Headquarters Information Form to fill out. Our Honolulu Committee needs this information so we can contact your family and friends waiting for your arrival. We will inform your contacts and hosts upon your mandatory check-ins and keep them current on your ETA. This is important for your hosts as well, as they spend days preparing for your arrival and I am sure you want your beverages cold and leis fresh.

The Host/Headquarters Information Form is extremely important. We must have local hotel information, names and phone numbers for your families, etc. After your yacht's arrival in Honolulu, we need the contact person/crew who is responsible for the boat while in Hawaii. We must have these contacts for safety requirements as well.

Race finish line can be viewed at the public look out next to the Diamond Head Lighthouse. The committee will do their best to take your immediate family out on a committee boat to view your finish if prior notice is given and we have the boats to accommodate them.
