SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

FIRST AMENDMENT

Sections 33.1, 33.3 and 39.1 of the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS dated May 20, 2003 are hereby amended as follows:

Section 33.1 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

“33.1 Mandatory roll call for boats that have started will be taken twice each day by the Communications Vessel ‘Alaska Eagle’ beginning July 2 on one of the following frequencies:

Primary	4146.0 kHz (4A)
Secondary	8294.0 kHz (8A)
Tertiary	12353.0 kHz (12A)

Assume primary frequency will be used unless otherwise directed. All yachts are requested to monitor VHF Channel 71 during roll call for relay of any positions or other information unable to be heard on SSB.”

Section 33.3 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

“33.3 Evening bed check roll call will commence at 1730 PDT (2230 Z). This check-in is also mandatory, but position reports are not required. Position reports may be given at the discretion of the skipper. The Communications Vessel will be standing by for early check-ins at 1715 PDT (2215 Z).”

Section 39.1 is hereby amended by adding at the end of such Section the following new sentence:

“This amends RRS 41.”
